

# Mine Action Update for April 2024

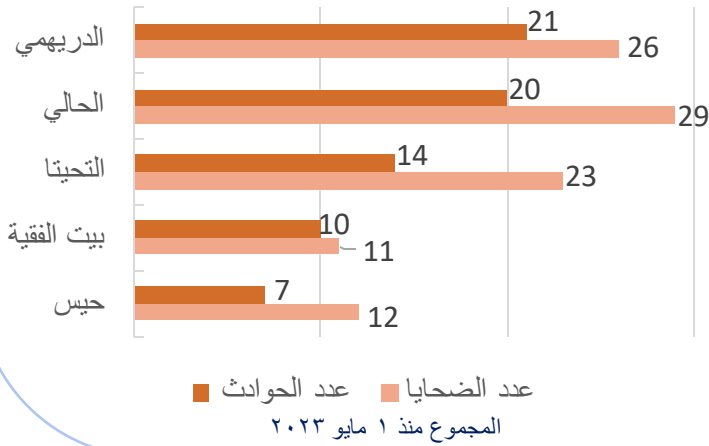
UNMHA recorded 4 explosive ordnance (EO) related incidents, resulting in a total of 6 civilian casualties in the Al-Hali, Al-Marawi'ah, and Bayt Al Faqih districts of the Hudaydah Governorate. 4 of these casualties were children, including 3 injuries and 1 death.

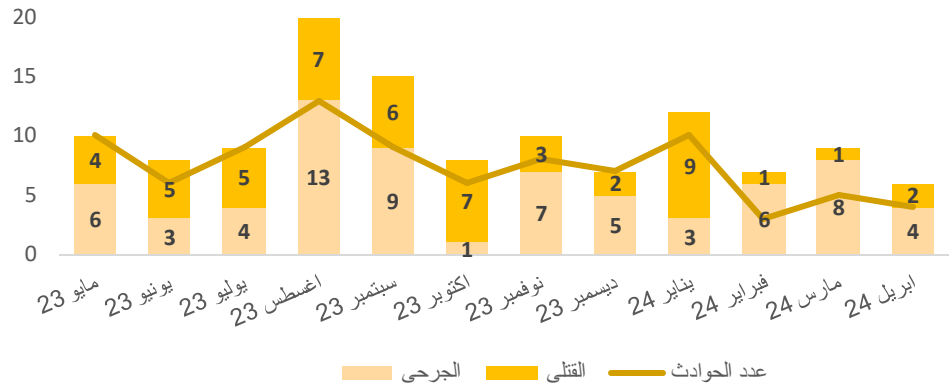

The UNMHA Mine Action team continued to engage with local authorities in Hudaydah, Sana'a and Aden as well as the UN Resident Coordinator's Office, United Nations country team, international NGOs and other international partners. The team provided coordination and technical support, including advocacy, through 17 dedicated activities. These activities included organizing events to commemorate International Mine Awareness Day on 4 April and participating in the 27th International Meeting of Mine Action National Directors and United Nations Advisers (NDM-UN27) in Geneva, where the team supported the Yemeni delegation and advocated for immediate assistance of the international community.
